#### IV. Discussion/Other

- Approval for Summer Curriculum Items

A motion was made for the Graduate Curriculum Committee co-chairs, Brad Johnson and Dennis LaJeunesse, to review/approve curriculum items over the summer on behalf of the GCC (Gargeya, Sultana). The motion was approved with 2 recusals.

- Vote on syllabus requirement for course proposals

The Graduate Curriculum Committee discussed requiring a syllabus to be uploaded in CIM when proposing new courses. Arguments in support of the requirement included the following:

- CIM will be a good repository for syllabi (departments often request copies of syllabi from when courses were approved)
- Having the syllabi in a central repository can provide guidance to departments when faculty leave
- Requiring a syllabus requires the faculty to flesh out the course completely before proposing the course
- Syllabi are currently required for experimental course shells and faculty have not had any issues providing them
- Requiring the syllabus would ensure that all the information intended to be captured in the CIM course form is available (committees often have questions due to incomplete information in CIM)
- The Undergraduate Curriculum Committee plans to request syllabi for new course proposals as well

Committee members expressed concern regarding requiring extra work for faculty and having to review full syllabi. Jodi emphasized that the committee would not be approving the actual syllabi but would be referring to the syllabi for further information about the proposed courses. The Office of Assessment, Accreditation, and Academic Program Planning will provide a template that departments can use for uploading syllabi/outlines for new courses.

A motion was made to require a syllabus/outline for new course proposals (Gargeya, Rakap). The motion passed with 4 votes in favor, 2 opposed, and 1 abstention.
