expectations depending on their level. This is reflected in the SLOs. Additionally, specific assignments may differ to better match these SLOs. Below are some examples:

- Students in CHE 768 will be required to present two papers instead of one throughout the semester.
- Students in CHE 768 will be required to include a proposal for additional research to more deeply examine the topic for each paper discussed in class
- Students in CHE 668 and 768 will be required to submit longer written summaries of discussed articles.
- Students in CHE 768 will develop a more comprehensive final project that includes a longer presentation and written document than students in CHE 668.
- Students in CHE 668 and 768 will be required to submit a written document to accompany the oral project of their final project. Students in CHE 468 will only be required to complete an oral presentation.
- Students in CHE 468 will have one fewer question on problem sets and in class exams.
