Quantitative Reasoning (chair, Jeff Sarbaum)

The goal is to determine how courses are adapting to the new MAC program.

Fall of 2023, departments were asked to complete a recertification form and upload a course syllabus. Subcommittees, chaired by a Council Member, will review course materials, and identify courses in two categories: Approved (notified and complete) and

Concerns/Questions (no decision made). The latter will require communication with the department and provide an opportunity to present more information and/or revise.

Drop-in sessions and workshops will be available for faculty to ask questions and receive assistance with revisions.

Early September deadline for revised/resubmitted proposals. The Council will need to discuss the consequences and a timeline for non-approved proposals. Council discussed committee membership and workload; Chair will communicate with departments.
